

4-H/FFA Wether Goat Project Show

Show: October 8, 2011

1. The 4-H/FFA Wether Goat Project Show is open to any 4-H or FFA Wether Goat Project participant who resides in South Carolina. Only project participants are allowed to show their project wether goat. As a project participant, you may exhibit one market doe in each of the doe classes as listed. Only the participant's project wether goat may be entered in the wether classes, unless the project wether dies prior to the show; then, the participant may enter and exhibit a doe in the appropriate wether showmanship division but may not exhibit in the wether market class.
2. Judging will begin at 11:00 a.m. on Saturday, October 8, 2011 in the Cattle Barn Show Arena at the Orangeburg County Fair.
3. All animals must be in the barn by 10:00 a.m. on show date in order to be weighed. It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to see that their animals are weighed prior to show time.
4. Deadline for entry is September 23, 2011.
5. Animals will be released after the completion of the show. There will be no removal of animals while the show is in progress. Any exhibitor removing animals before completion of the 4-H/FFA Wether Goat Project Show forfeits premiums and/or awards.
6. Each exhibitor and one accompanying adult will be mailed a ticket to enter the Fair on the show date. Additional passes may be purchased in advance or at the gate. Only vehicles transporting animals will be allowed in gate.
7. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water and maintain their exhibits, keeping space and stalls clean. Bedding will be provided. Failure to comply can result in forfeiture of premiums and/or awards.
8. Exhibitors must be able to maintain control of their animal(s) at all times during this event.
9. The Orangeburg County Fair Manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changing rules, regulations, and/or health requirements. Any animal exhibiting any significant visible symptoms of disease or sickness will not be allowed to be unloaded from the vehicle or remain on the fair grounds. **Before the animal is unloaded, each exhibitor must provide a valid Health Certificate, issued within 30 days of the show, from a licensed SC veterinarian, certifying that the animal was free of contagious, infectious or communicable diseases.**
10. All decisions by judges will be final.
11. Any questions, complaints, disagreements are to be made to the Cattle Barn Manager.
12. Exhibitors and other persons practicing unsportsmanlike behavior or not adhering to the show rules will be asked to leave the show barn; in this case, such exhibitors will be barred from competition and receipt of premiums and/or awards.
13. Exhibitors will unload their animals and supplies and move all vehicles and trailers to designated parking areas.
14. Orangeburg County Fair reserves the right to cancel shows due to lack of youth participation.
15. Wether Goat Market Classes will be divided on the basis of official weight of the wether on the date of the project kickoff event and will be listed as Class I – V.
16. Showmanship classes will be divided by the age of the child as of January 1st of the current year and will be listed as follows:
 - Senior Division – must be age 14 and must not be age 19 on January 1st of the current year
 - Junior Division – must be age 12 and must not be age 14 on January 1st of the current year
 - Cloverleaf- must be age 9 and must not be age 12 on January 1st of the current year
 - Cloverbud Division – must be age 5 and must not be age 9 on January 1st of the current year
