Eligibility: All artists in Orangeburg County, adjoining counties, and Orangeburg League of Arts members are eligible to enter.

ART SHOW GUIDELINES

- (A) You are allowed 2 entries for judging, and should be no larger than 48" x 48" (including frame).
- (B) Each entry should have a tag with name, media, and phone number. These tags, available at the Fair, will be attached to the wire in the back of the work and hung over the frame in front when entered.
- (C) All artwork will remain on display for the duration of the Fair and may not be removed after 5PM on the last Sunday the Fair runs. Any work that is not picked up during this time will be taken to the Orangeburg Arts Center on Riverside Drive, where it will be until December 1.
- (D). Artwork must have been completed within the previous 3 years and not previously exhibited at the Fair.
- (E) Work must be completely **original** and not a copy of any work by another artist, published work, or cartoon.
- (F) Step by step class work cannot be accepted for judging. Art done under the surveillance of an instructor is acceptable if the instructor had not done the actual work.
- (G) Responsibility for all work - theft, defacing, loss - is entirely the artist's. Although all possible care will be taken, the Orangeburg League of the Arts and the Fair management do not assume responsibility.
- (H) The Art Show and Fair committees reserve the right to refuse any work deemed
- (I) Judging will be done by a competent, experienced judge selected by the Orangeburg League of the Arts and capable of judging in each area of the exhibit. All decisions will be final.
- (J) Each work must be wired for hanging, framed, matted and/or glazed appropriately for the work. **If a piece cannot be hung by itself, or does not stay on the wall as hung, the art show committee will disqualify it and will be under no obligation to repair it.**
- (K) No painting will be allowed to leave Fairground property without proper authorization by Orangeburg League of Arts Representation. (Stub **MUST** match Registration Tag)

JUNIOR ART EXHIBIT

ELIGIBILITY: All Orangeburg County and surrounding counties children grades K through 12 are eligible.

ENTRY: Drawings or paintings must have been done within the past year and not previously exhibited at the Fair.

No exhibitor may enter more than one painting.

Work must be completely original and not a copy of any published photograph or work of art by another artist.

All entries must have a minimum two inch border or mat to which a tag or label may be attached and stapled to the wall. No framed or glassed pictures!

There will be ribbons and cash awards for each grade: 1st - \$10.00; 2nd - \$5.00

The Art & Fair committees reserve the right to refuse to show any picture it considers unsuitable.

Pictures must be entered at the fair booth on Sunday, October 2, 2:00 - 4:00 P.M. and removed Sunday, October 9, after 5P.M.

Each entry should have name, school, age, grade and telephone number on back of painting.
