

**4-H Commercial Dairy Heifer Show**  
**Show: October 5, 2011**  
**Show: Immediately following 4-H/FFA/Youth Dairy Heifer Show**

1. The 4-H Commercial Dairy Heifer Show is open to any youth, ages 5 – 19, who is affiliated with a 4-H/FFA group in Orangeburg County. This show is for heifers only.
2. Judging will begin immediately following the 4-H/FFA/Youth Dairy Heifer Show on Wednesday, October 5, 2011 in the Cattle Barn Show Arena at the Orangeburg County Fair.
3. All animals will be received beginning at 10:00 a.m. on the day of the show. All animals must be in the barn by 3:00 p.m. on show date.
4. Deadline for entry is September 23, 2011.
5. Commercial Dairy Show Exhibitors **may not** show the same animal in the 4-H/FFA/Youth Dairy Show Conformation or Showmanship class.
6. Exhibitors must show proof of animal's date of birth.
7. Animals will be released after the completion of the show. There will be no removal of animals while the show is in progress. Any exhibitor removing animals before completion of the show forfeits premiums and/or awards.
8. Each exhibitor and one accompanying adult will be mailed a ticket to enter the Fair on the show date. Additional passes may be purchased in advance or at the gate. Only vehicles transporting animals will be allowed in gate.
9. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water and maintain their exhibits, keeping space and stalls clean. Bedding will be provided. Failure to comply can result in forfeiture of premiums and/or awards.
10. The Orangeburg County Fair manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changes to rules, regulations, and/or health requirements. Any animal exhibiting any significant visible symptoms of disease or sickness will not be allowed in the cattle barn or on the fairgrounds. Health requirements are subject to change prior to show date.
11. All decisions by judges will be final.
12. Any questions, complaints, disagreements are to be made to the Cattle Barn Manager.
13. Exhibitors and other persons practicing unsportsmanlike behavior or not adhering to the show rules will be asked to leave the show barn; in this case, such exhibitors will be barred from competition and receipt of premiums and/or awards.
14. Exhibitors will unload their animals and supplies and move all vehicles and trailers to designated parking areas.
15. Orangeburg County Fair reserves the right to cancel shows due to lack of youth participation.
16. Showmanship classes will be divided by the age of the child as of January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year and will be listed as follows:

Senior Division – must be age 14 and must not be age 19 on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year  
Junior Division – must be age 9 and must not be age 14 on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year  
Cloverbud Division – must be age 5 and must not be age 9 on January 1<sup>st</sup> of the current year

1. The 4-H/FFA/Youth Dairy Heifer Show is open to any youth, ages 5 – 19, residing in South Carolina. This show is for heifers only.
2. Judging will begin at 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 5, 2011 in the Cattle Barn Show Arena at the Orangeburg County Fair.
3. All animals will be received beginning at 10:00 a.m. on the day of the show. All animals must be in the barn by 3:00 p.m. on show date.
4. Deadline for entry is September 23, 2011.
5. Exhibitors must have owned all animals at least 45 days prior to the date of the show.
6. Exhibitors must show their own animals in the Showmanship Classes.
7. Exhibitors may show only 3 animals of each breed (Guernsey, Jersey, and Holstein) that have been transferred to his/her name.
8. Dairy cattle will be received beginning at 10:00 a.m. on day of show and must be checked in by 3:00 p.m. Registration papers or affidavits must be presented at check-in.
9. Conformation classes will be divided by breed. Holstein classes will show first, followed by Jersey and Guernsey classes.
10. Showmanship classes will be shown with all breeds combined.
11. Animals will be released after the completion of the show. There will be no removal of animals while the show is in progress. Any exhibitor removing animals before completion of the show forfeits premiums and/or awards.
12. Each exhibitor and one accompanying adult will be mailed a ticket to enter the Fair on the show date. Additional passes may be purchased in advance or at the gate. Only vehicles transporting animals will be allowed in gate.
13. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water and maintain their exhibits, keeping space and stalls clean. Bedding will be provided. Failure to comply can result in forfeiture of premiums and/or awards.
14. The Orangeburg County Fair manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning or changes to rules, regulations, and/or health requirements.
