Orangeburg County Fair Flower Show -October 3 - October 9, 2011

Class I	1911 -1930--Orange <u>Omit: Dogwood</u>	Must use orange flower, fresh material only, traditional design
Class II	1931-1950--Yellow <u>Omit: Hoe 'n' Hope</u>	use <u>only</u> yellow flowers, fresh and/or dried material, designer's choice of design
Class III	1951-1970—Green <u>Omit: Palmetto</u>	foliage <u>only</u> fresh material only, creative design
Class IV	1971-1990—Brown <u>Omit: Wisteria</u>	dried material only, designer's choice of design
Class V	1991-2011—Pink Ribbon <u>Omit: Azalea</u>	must use pink flowers & ribbon, fresh and/or dried material, creative design

Rules and Regulations

1. Judging will conform to rules of the National Garden Clubs, Inc.
2. No State conservation materials are permitted in any arrangement.
3. No artificial flowers allowed.
4. Dried material may be waxed, dyed, flocked, painted, glittered or etched.
5. Accessories may be used in all classes.
6. No cut or prepared food allowed.
7. Some plant materials must be used in every exhibit.
8. Do not use plant shine on fresh flowers. Just wipe leaves with water and check for bug damage.
9. Each Garden Club will be responsible for four designs.
10. All arrangements will be staged against covered backboards (40" high x 30" wide) and baseboards (19" deep x 30" wide) Arrangements should not extend above top or beyond side of backboard.
11. All exhibits must be entered between 9:00 a.m. and 12:00 noon, Sunday, October 2,
12. The Flower Show will be open to the public at 5:00 p.m. Monday or when judging is complete.
13. All arrangements must be picked up Sunday at the close of the fair after 5:00 p.m.

Expression (interpretation of class by exhibitor)	10
Distinction (marked superiority)	16
