

4-H Backyard Rabbit Show
Show: Saturday, October 8, 2011

1. All exhibitors in the 4-H Backyard Rabbit Show must be registered 4-H members in the 4-H Backyard Rabbit project. The 4-H Backyard Rabbit Project is open to any youth, ages 5 – 19.
2. Judging will begin at 2 pm on Saturday, October 8, 2011 in the Cattle Barn Show Arena at the Orangeburg County Fair.
3. All exhibitors should be registered with the show staff starting at 1 pm on show date.
4. Deadline for entry is September 23, 2011.
5. Animals will be released after the completion of the show. There will be no removal of animals while the show is in progress. Any exhibitor removing animals before the completion of the show will forfeit premiums and/or awards.
6. Each exhibitor and one accompanying adult will be given a ticket to enter the Fair on the show date. Additional passes may be purchased in advance or at the gate.
7. Exhibitors must provide their own feed and water and maintain their rabbits while at the Fair. Failure to comply can result in forfeiture of premiums and/or awards.
8. The Orangeburg County Fair manager reserves the right to make decisions concerning changes to rules, regulations, and/or health requirements.
9. All judges' decisions will be final.
10. Exhibitors and other persons practicing unsportsmanlike behavior or not adhering to the show rules will be asked to leave the show barn; in this case, such exhibitors will be barred from competition and receipt of premiums and/or awards.
11. Showmanship classes will be divided by the age of the child as of January 1st of the current year and will be listed as follows:
 - a. Senior Division – must be age 14 and must not be age 19 on January 1st of the current year.
 - b. Junior Division – must be age 9 and must not be age 14 on January 1st of the current year.
 - c. Cloverbud Division – must be age 5 and must not be age 9 on January 1st of the current year.
